SOUTHWEST ASIA – Across Iraq and Syria, the Combined Joint Task Force – Operation Inherent Resolve, in conjunction with our partner forces, works to ensure an enduring defeat of Daesh (ISIS). CJTF-OIR provides high-level advising and enabling of our partner forces to defeat Daesh remnants and set conditions for follow on operations to increase regional regional stability. The aircraft have been operating in the Middle East Region as part of Australia's Air Task Group 630. While deployed, they performed airborne command and control and air-to-air refueling missions.
