SOUTHWEST ASIA – Across Iraq and Syria, the Combined Joint Task Force – Operation Inherent Resolve, in conjunction with our partner forces, works to ensure an enduring defeat of Daesh (ISIS). CJTF-OIR provides high-level advising and enabling of our partner forces to defeat Daesh remnants and set conditions for follow on operations to increase regional stability. Since 2014, the Coalition has military contributions from more than 30 nations.

Air Brigadier General Tardif views Baghdad Prison extension sites

The Director of DICE, Air Brigade General (GBA) Dominique Tardif, SNR-O of Operation CHAMMAL, traveled to Iraq, where he went to the site planned for the future extension site of the Baghdad prison, located near the international airport.

Funded by the coalition committed to the fight against Daesh in Iraq and Syria, initiated and supervised by the Director of Interagency and Civilian Environment, this project will open in early 2021 with an intent to increase by more than 400 places by the end of the year.

This extension aims to relieve congestion in Iraqi establishments whose overcrowding poses a significant security and health risk.

Launched on September 19, 2014, Operation CHAMMAL represents the French component of OPERATION INHERENT RESOLVE (OIR) bringing together 80 countries and organizations. The International Coalition is constantly adapting its device to the Levant and France is continuing its efforts in the region because the fight against terrorism continues. Operation CHAMMAL is now focused on its “support” pillar and has 600 soldiers inserted within the OIR headquarters or on air and sea deployments.
