Chief Master Sergeant Antonio J. Goldstrom is the Command Chief Master Sergeant, 9th Air Expeditionary Task Force – Levant, Southwest Asia. As the senior enlisted leader, Chief Goldstrom executes the commander's intent and is responsible for advising on all aspects of operational employment, training, readiness, resilience, and development of over 5,000 total force Airmen and contractors across three air expeditionary wings. Chief Goldstrom also serves as the interim Command Senior Enlisted Leader, Combined Joint Task Force – Operation INHERENT RESOLVE. In this capacity, he advises the Commanding General and senior staff on joint and coalition operations in the fight against the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria.

Chief Master Sergeant Goldstrom entered the Air Force in November 1993. His diverse support and operational experience includes various duties in the Information Management, Cyberspace Support, and First Sergeant career fields at the squadron, group, wing, Joint Staff, and Air Staff levels. His assignments include bases in Texas, Washington D.C., and Arizona. He also served overseas in Korea, Germany, and deployed in direct support of Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, and hurricane relief operations. Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Command Chief, 12th Flying Training Wing, JBSA-Randolph, Texas.
