

Qayyarah Airfield West, Iraq – Combat operations against ISIS



In support of the Iraqi Security Forces, U.S. Soldiers assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 8th Field Artillery Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division, fire a M777 towed 155 mm howitzer at Qayyarah Airfield West, Iraq, Sept. 10, 2019.
