## **Defeating Daesh Highlights of the Week**

**SOUTHWEST ASIA** – Our partners in Iraq and Syria are leading the way to find and eliminate ISIS fighters, finance, logistics, and media networks.

"Our Iraqi and Syrian partners continue to perform search and clearance operations to weed out remnants of Daesh," said Col. Myles B. Caggins III, Coalition military spokesman. "The Iraqi Security Forces, Peshmerga Forces and Syrian Democratic Forces are not only providing security to the region, but are also bridging relationships with its locals to enhance community cohesion. Their efforts, combined with Coalition support, strengthens a sense of unity to pursue a common goal: to prevent a resurgence of Daesh and protect the lives of innocent civilians."

### During the week of February 27- March 4, 2020, the following actions happened in Iraq:

 Feb. 27: The 6th Iraqi Infantry Division carried out a pre-emptive operation to search for criminals wanted by the Iraqi Judiciary in the al-Tarmiyah area. - Feb. 28: Iraqi Security Forces carried out a search operation in the Kirkuk province to pursue Daesh terrorists and stop sources of terrorism. <u>https://www.facebook.com/SecMedCell/posts/606402856808792?</u>
- Feb. 29: Units from the Samarra Operations Command conducted a search and clearance operation on West Samarra Island. A number of explosive devices were seized and disposed of during the operation making the area safer for local Iraqis.

 March 1: A force from the 19th Infantry Brigade, the 5th Division, Diyala Operations Command, conducted a search operation in the south Buhrez district. A Daesh hideout was destroyed and an arms cache containing explosive devices, artillery and mortar rounds was seized and subsequently destroyed.

- March 2: Based on intelligence reports, the 39th, 40th and 41st Infantry Brigades, and the Surveillance Regiment from the 10th Division of the Anbar Operations Command, launched a series of search operations across Anbar province, backed by the Iraqi Army Aviation, tribal crowds and Popular Mobilization Forces to hunt down Daesh terrorists. A Daesh hideout and a safe house were destroyed, five Daesh terrorists were eliminated, weapons caches and a number of explosive devices were seized and disposed of. <u>https://www.facebook.com/mod.mil.iq/posts/27766</u> 72439228910?



 March 2: The Salah Ad-Din Operations Command coordinated search and clearance operations on Salah Ad-Din Island and the western area of Tharthar Valley targeting Daesh sleeper cells throughout the area. Two Daesh safe houses, logistical supplies and two motorcycles were destroyed and a weapons cache and explosive devices were seized and disposed of. The operations were carried out jointly with units from the Ninawa Operations Command, Popular Mobilization Forces, SWAT and the Tactical

 March 3: Military Intelligence Detachments, in coordination with the 9th Emergency Regiment and a joint security force, conducted a series of operations in the Ninawa province. Two terrorists, wanted by the Iraqi Judiciary, were arrested and a tunnel belonging to Daesh terrorists was destroyed, with explosive devices and other explosives seized and disposed of. The arrested individuals had taken part in a number of terrorist acts against local civilians.
