Defeating Daesh Highlights of the Week

SOUTHWEST ASIA – Our partners in Iraq and Syria are leading the way to find and eliminate ISIS fighters, finance, logistics, and media networks.

"Despite the challenges from COVID-19, our Iraqi and Syrian partners continue to degrade Daesh's capabilities," said Col. Myles B. Caggins III, Coalition military spokesman. "In Iraq, the Coalition departed several compounds inside Iraqi bases, in recent weeks, but we remain partnered with the ISF for anti-ISIS operations."

Between March 19 and April 7, 2020, the following actions happened in Iraq:

March 21: Iraqi F-16 fighter jets carried out an airstrike on Daesh hideouts in the Hamrin mountain range. Dozens of terrorists were killed and their hideouts were destroyed during the operation.

 March 21: A joint force from Diyala Operations Command carried out a search operation in the village of al-Naqeeb, south of Buhriz district. A Daesh hideout containing weapons and explosives was found and destroyed.

March 22: Based on intelligence, a force from the 3rd Division of the Federal Police carried out a clearing operation in the villages of al-Atshanah and al-Mansuriya, Kirkuk province. A weapons cache was seized and safely disposed of.

- March 25: The 50th Infantry Brigade, 14th Infantry Division conducted a search operation around Crow Mountain in Makhmour district. The operation, supported by Iraqi Army Aviation, aimed to eliminate the movement of ISIS cells in areas of rough terrain. The operation achieved its objectives, denying Daesh the resources they need to regenerate and prevent terrorist infiltration into the villages.

March 25: Units from the 1st and 10th Infantry
Divisions, Anbar Commandos Brigade, the
Emergency Brigade Directorate, and the Anbar Tribal
Forces, with the support of elements from the security
agencies, the Explosive Ordnance Detachments and
Iraqi Army Aviation, carried out a series of search
operations. A Daesh safe house was found containing
weapons and explosives that were all subsequently
destroyed.

March 26: The 5th Infantry Division, Diyala
 Operations Command, and the Diyala Police
 Directorate, with the support of Iraqi Army Aviation,
 carried out a raid in the al-Mukhaisa and Abu Karmah
 areas, Abu Saida district, north of Baquba, to hunt
 down ISIS terrorists, destroy their hideouts, arrest
 criminals and impose security and stability in these
 areas. A Daesh safe house containing explosives was
 found and destroyed.

 March 27: A series of search operations were conducted by several units from Samarra Operations Command on West Samarra Island, al-Mukeshefah Island, and al-Ishaqi area. - March 30: A joint force from the Forward Headquarters of Kirkuk Joint Operations Command destroyed 24 ISIS hideouts near Tuz Khurmatu, Salah Ad-Din province. Motorcycles, explosive devices, fuel and supplies were found in the hideouts. - April 1: Based on intelligence, a force from the 5th
 Division conducted a search operation in al-Horrah
 area northeast Diyala. Five Daesh safe houses were
 found that contained explosives and supplies and
