#### **Defeating Daesh Highlights of the Week**

**SOUTHWEST ASIA** – Our partners in Iraq and Syria are leading the way to find and eliminate ISIS fighters and their finance, logistics, and media networks.

"This month seven nations have flow anti-ISIS air support missions, including: Iraq, Australia, Canada, France, Germany, United Kingdom, and the United States," said Col. Myles B. Caggins III, Coalition military spokesman. "The air missions include moving cargo, people, collecting intelligence, and dropping bombs on ISIS hideouts. All air missions are coordinated with the Government of Iraq and, ultimately, support the ISF and SDF in their goal of eradicating Daesh from the region."

#### During the week of April 22 - 28, 2020, the following actions happened in Iraq:

 April 22: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 16th Division and the 76th Infantry Brigade, in coordination with the Ninawa Operations Command Intelligence Unit, , found and destroyed a Daesh hideout containing food supplies, clothes and vehicle registration plates during a clearance operation in the village of Umm al-Edham, southwest of Mosul. <a href="https://www.facebook.com/Intelligence153/posts/1">https://www.facebook.com/Intelligence153/posts/1</a>

 April 23: In an intelligence-led operation, a joint force from Diyala Operations Command clashed with, and trapped terrorist elements inside a hideout I in the al-Khalawiyah area, bordering Lake Hamrin in Qarah Tapah district. The terrorists, trying to escape towards

Lake Hamrin, were attacked by the Iraqi Army Aviation, killing seven. The security forces subsequently destroyed the hideout that contained goods, a motorcycle, 8 barrels of gasoline and two gas canisters.  April 23: Troops from Ninawa Operations Command – West, carried out a clearance operation in the area of al-Jazeerah. Five Daesh hideouts were destroyed. One of the hideouts was considered a command center containing explosives and logistical supplies. Three terrorists were killed. Additionally, two motorcycles were destroyed and four explosive devices were dismantled by the Field Engineering Unit.

April 24: The Military Intelligence Detachment, 8th Division, in cooperation with the 32nd Infantry Brigade, seized and safely destroyed a cache of ammunition and explosives, remnants from Daesh, in al-Qaim district, Anbar province.

- April 26: The Military Intelligence Detachment, 1st Division, in cooperation with the 4th Infantry Brigade, raided a Daesh hideout containing a weapons cache, several vehicle registration plates and logistics materials in al-Taba'at area southwest of al-Rutba, Anbar province. The hideout was safely destroyed by the Field Engineering Unit.

April 27: Forces from Salah Ad-Din Operations Command, with the support of the
provincial police and Popular Mobilization Forces, launched a large-scale operation in
al-Mutaibijah area (Hawi al-Edhem) and the villages located on the borders between
Diyala, Salah Ad-Din and Samarra to pursue Daesh remnants and enhance security
and stability in the area. Three Daesh hideouts containing medical and food supplies,
two tunnels and a booby-trapped boat were destroyed and an explosive device was
detonated. Additionally, a bomb-making factory containing explosive devices and
detonators was found and destroyed during the ongoing operation in al-Maytah village
in Hawi al-Edhem.

April 27: During a military operation, a unit from Samarra Operations Command arrested a terrorist who was previously working as an executions officer in Daesh. April 27: A force from Samara Operations Command, found and destroyed a number of explosive devices during a search operation on al-Mukeshefah Island. Additionally, a joint force from the 1st Division of the Federal Police, Commando Brigade, Samara Operations Command and affiliated units, supported by the Iraqi Army Aviation commenced a search operation in areas near the Samarra- Al-Dour main road and Lake of Salt.
