### **Defeating Daesh Highlights of the Week**

**SOUTHWEST ASIA** – Our partners in Iraq and Syria are leading the way to find and eliminate Daesh fighters and their finance, logistics, and media networks.

"The recent flurry of ISIS activity has been met by a blizzard of Iraqi Security Forces tactical operation across north central Iraq and Anbar Province," said Col. Myles B. Caggins III, Coalition military spokesman. "The international military Coalition continues to support our Iraqi and Syrian partners as they take the fight to Daesh."

#### Between April 29 and May 5, 2020, the following actions happened in Iraq:

- April 29: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 1st Division, in cooperation with the 1st Regiment, 4th Brigade, arrested two terrorists wanted by the Iraqi Judiciary at the intersection of al-Waleed and Trebil in al-Rutba district, Anbar province. <a href="https://www.facebook.com/Intelligence153/posts/1559316187576729">https://www.facebook.com/Intelligence153/posts/1559316187576729</a>
- April 29: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 15th Division, in cooperation with the 3rd Regiment, 73rd Brigade, arrested a terrorist wanted by the Iraqi Judiciary during an ambush in Zammar sub-district, west of Mosul. https://www.facebook.com/Intelligence153/posts/1559421870899494
- April 29-30: Coalition forces conducted airstrikes on Daesh fighters hiding in ten caves across the Hamrin Mountains, Iraq, April 29, 2020.

The airstrikes were conducted in coordination with the Government of Iraq. After the strikes, the 14th Iraqi Army Division and security forces found Daesh documents, electronic devices, and fragments of weapons and other equipment. The ground search continues; much of the cave complex is inaccessible but post-strike initial

estimates are five to ten Daesh fighters were killed.

Additionally, troops from the Iraqi Counter Terrorism Service conducted a ground clearance operation shortly after the Coalition airstrike on Daesh fighters hiding in caves across the Hamrin Mountains, Iraq, April 30, 2020.

• April 30: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 1st Brigade and the Commando Regiment, affiliated with the 1st Division, Anbar Operations Command, conducted a rough terrain airborne operation between Wadi Al-Hazimi and Wadi Ashisha, east of al-Rutba district, Anbar province. Two hideouts containing fuel and water tanks and logistical supplies were captured and safely destroyed. Additionally, one ISIS vehicle was seized north of the area.

May 1: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 1st Division, in cooperation with the 2nd Regiment, 53rd Infantry Brigade, thwarted a car bomb attack east of al-Rutba district, Anbar province. The force chased the vehicle and clashed with the terrorists who escaped the scene leaving behind a boobytrapped vehicle before targeting Iraqi Security Forces. The vehicle was seized and subsequently safely destroyed by the Field Engineering Unit.  May 1: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 8th Division, in cooperation with the 30th and 32nd Infantry Brigades, arrested three terrorists wanted by the Iraqi Judiciary in al-Rummana area, al-Qaim district, Anbar province. One of the terrorists was responsible for the transportation operation of Daesh's oil and worked within the so-called "Diwan al-Zakat".

May 1: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 7th Division, in cooperation with the Intelligence Units of the 29th Infantry Brigade and the 1st Regiment, 27th Brigade found two Daesh hideouts containing explosive devices, detonators, explosives and a motorcycle during a search operation southeast of Kubaisah sub-district, Anbar province.  May 2: Military Intelligence Detachments from 14th Division, in cooperation with the Intelligence Unit of the 1st Regiment, 51st Infantry Brigade seized a weapons cache during a search operation in Wadi Rakhmah, al-Zab sub-district, Kirkuk province. The cache was subsequently destroyed in a controlled explosion.

The Iraqi forces clashed with the militants and wounded two of them, while the rest fled towards Qanus Island, leaving behind their weapons, ammunition and equipment.

 May 4: Military Intelligence Detachments from the 10th Division, in cooperation with the 1st Regiment, 39th Brigade, found and safely destroyed a Daesh hideout containing explosive devices, remnants from Daesh, in al-Tharthar desert in Anbar.

- May 4: Combined forces from Anbar Operations Command, Jazeerah Operations Command, and Popular Mobilization Forces West Anbar, with the support of Iraqi Army Aviation and Air Force, launched a large-scale anti-Daesh offensive dubbed 'Desert Lions' in Wadi Houran, Husayniyyat al-Ka'rah, H3, Wadi al-Halkum, and the areas up to the international borders. The operation aims to enhance security and stability in these areas, pursue terrorist elements and arrest wanted criminals. #### Between April 29 and May 5, 2020, the following actions happened in Syria:

 May 1: The elite Counter-Terrorism Unit within the Syrian Democratic Forces, with air cover from the Coalition, arrested a Daesh cell and seized their weapons and equipment in Hajin area east of Deir ez-Zor.
